

## INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this **22nd** day of **September**, 2009 between the **BOROUGH OF PRINCETON**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, whose address is One Monument Drive, Princeton, New Jersey 08542 (hereinafter referred to as the "Borough") and the **TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, whose address is 400 Witherspoon Street, Princeton, New Jersey 08540 (hereinafter referred to as the "Township").

WHEREAS, the Township currently employs a crossing guard to direct vehicular and pedestrian traffic during school days at the intersection of Walnut Lane and Franklin Avenue Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has proposed that it provide, at its expense, a second crossing guard, to be located in an area adjacent to the intersection of Walnut Lane and Franklin Avenue (within the Borough) to provide additional assistance with respect to direction of vehicular and pedestrian traffic control during school days between the hours of 8:00 AM to 8:30 AM and 2:55 PM and 3:25 PM; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate increased traffic control at the intersection of Walnut Lane and Franklin Avenue, the Borough and the Township believe that it is necessary and appropriate to enter into a shared services agreement, as provided by *N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.*


It is therefore agreed by and between the Borough and the Township as follows:

1. The Township shall provide, at its expense, a crossing guard to be located adjacent to the intersection of Walnut Lane and Franklin Avenue, within the Borough, to provide assistance with vehicular and pedestrian traffic control during school days between the hours of

8: 00 AM and 8:30 AM and 2:55 PM and 3: 25 PM, subject to school schedule changes. The crossing guard shall be under the jurisdiction and control of the Township and the Township shall be responsible for any cost or liability associated with the use of the guard.


2. This Agreement shall be in full force and effect for a period of five (5) years, beginning with the execution date set forth above and may be terminated by either municipality upon 30 days written notice to the other.




