

INTER-LOCAL SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered this 10th day of November, 2008.

BETWEEN: Township of Manchester
A municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey
1 Colonial Drive
Manchester, New Jersey 08759
(Hereinafter referred to as Township);

AND: Borough of Lakehurst
5 Union Avenue
Lakehurst, New Jersey 08733

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 provides that any local unit of the State may enter into contracts with other units for the purposes of joint services within their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Manchester and the Borough of Lakehurst are desirous of entering into an agreement for the services of extra duty police officers from both the Manchester Township Police Department and the Lakehurst Borough Police Department to work in the other's jurisdiction for the purpose of providing police services for highway construction projects to alleviate the possibility of manpower shortage.

NOW, THEREFORE, each municipality in consideration for the mutual promises and agreements hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Each municipality shall establish a separate escrow account for contractors to deposit monies to pay for the officers requested by the contractors.
2. The fees for officers requested from the Township of Manchester and the Borough of Lakehurst shall be \$65.00 per hour; \$50.00 of which is earned by each officer and \$15.00 of which is an administrative fee to the municipality whose officer is requested and is utilized to be paid by the contractors to the appropriate municipality.
3. Either party to this agreement may cancel this contract upon thirty (30) days written notice.
4. The officers shall be paid extra duty pay by the municipality by whom the officer is employed directly to the officer.
