ORDINANCE #1992-15
TOWNSHIP OF EAST WINDSOR
COUNTY OF MERCER

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF EAST WINDSOR AUTHORIZING AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST WINDSOR
AND THE BOROUGH OF HIGHTSTOWN
FOR HEALTH SERVICES

WHEREAS, East Windsor Township employs a Health Officer and
WHEREAS, Hightstown Borough desires to contract with East
Windsor Township for provision of services of a Health Officer;
and

WHEREAS, East Windsor Township is agreeable to providing the
services of a Health Officer to Hightstown Borough for a fee and
upon certain specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, the "Interlocal Services Act", N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et
seq., permits local units of this State to enter into a contract
with any other local unit for the joint provision within their
combined jurisdictions of any service which any party to the
agreement is empowered to render within its own jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the
Township of East Windsor, County of Mercer and State of New
Jersey as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed
to execute a document entitled, "Interlocal Agreement between
East Windsor Township and Hightstown Borough for Health
Services", a true copy of which is appended hereto and
incorporated herein by reference.


2A. The attached one year Interlocal Services Agreement is hereby approved and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute same and four 4 annual renewals of same, subject to final approval of the Township Council.


B. Subject to approval by the Township Council by a resolution, the fees set forth in the contract may be adjusted annually based upon actual experience and negotiation with the Borough of Hightstown as set forth in said contract, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-6(a).

3. This Ordinance shall be null and void unless a complimentary Ordinance is adopted by the Governing Body of Hightstown Borough, Mercer County, and the attached agreement is executed by all parties within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this Ordinance as set forth in paragraph 4.

4 This Ordinance shall take effect twenty 20) days after final passage and publication according to law.
