

INTER-LOCAL SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered this 19th day of July, 2001.

BETWEEN: Township of Manchester  
A municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey  
1 Colonial Drive  
Manchester, New Jersey 08759  
(hereinafter referred to as Township);

AND: Borough of Lakehurst  
5 Union Avenue  
Lakehurst, New Jersey 08733  
(hereinafter referred to as Borough)

Whereas, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq., authorizes two or more local units to provide by an inter-local service agreement through the agency of one of the contracting parties, any service or aspect of a service which any of the parties on whose behalf such services are to be performed may legally perform for itself; and,

Whereas, the parties hereto are desirous of providing a mobile data communication system via Bell Atlantic Mobile Service, by the Township of Manchester to the Borough of Lakehurst under the terms and conditions provided for herein.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Township shall provide to the Borough a mobile data communication system, via Bell Atlantic Mobile Service.
2. The Township shall bill the Borough on a monthly basis for the use of the mobile data communication system. The amount to be \$34.37 per month per M.D.T. unit.
3. All other rules and regulations necessary to effectuate the intent of this contract shall be negotiated and agreed to between the respective parties.
4. Either party to this agreement may cancel this contract upon thirty (30) days written notice.
5. The parties to this agreement agree to incorporate into this agreement the mandatory language of subsection 3.4(a) of the regulations promulgated by the treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, c. 127, as amended and supplemented from time to time and the contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully

with the terms, provisions and obligations of said section 5.3. In addition, and to the extent applicable by law, the contractor under this agreement agrees to comply with those undertaking of the "procurement and service contract mandatory language" attached hereto as Exhibit A.
