<b>A-4942</b> Peterson, Erik	Provides reimbursement to volunteer emergency service organizations for expenses incurred in response to certain false alarms; makes appropriations.	Assembly Law and Public Safety Committee	A
<b>A-4961</b> Land, Bruce Andrzejczak, Bob	Requires public utility to charge veterans' organization residential rate for service delivered to property at which veterans' organization primarily operates.	Assembly Telecommunications and Utilities Committee	A

<b>S-3161</b>  Vitale, Joseph Addiego, Dawn Marie	Provides that cooperative sober living residences are inherently beneficial uses.  <i>Leads to a burden shift upon challenge to a denial of zoning variance. Unnecessary as sober living residences may already be considered a beneficial use.</i>	Assembly Human Services Committee	<b>O</b>
<b>S-3184</b>  Holzapfel, James	Requires State aid reduction to municipalities and school districts by amount of accumulated absences paid to employees upon their retirement.  <i>Punishes taxpayers for legacy payments.</i>	Senate Community and Urban Affairs Committee	<b>O</b>
<b>S-3215</b>  Stack, Brian	Establishes residential rental property inspection findings database.  <i>Additional burdens on municipalities; likely an unfunded mandate.</i>	Senate Community and Urban Affairs Committee	<b>O</b>
<b>S-3245</b>  Diegnan, Patrick	Updates notice of elections requirements to include information for voter to obtain polling place locations.  <i>Troubling to municipalities. <b>S-3253</b>  Bucco, Anthony	Waives certain inspection fees for municipally owned affordable housing developments.	Senate Community and Urban Affairs Committee	<b>A</b>
