| S-2206 Sweeney, Stephen M. | Provides that State or local appointing authority in civil service may institute temporary layoff. | Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee | A |
| S-2334 Norcross, Donald | Converts four paid holidays to administrative leave days; provides State and local government offices remain open for business on those days. <i>Interferes with local autonomy on when to be open or closed for holidays.</i> | Senate State Government, Wagering, Tourism & Historic Preservation Committee | O |
| S-2404 Kean, Sean T. | Caps attorney fee awards in actions against public entities. | Senate Judiciary Committee | A |
| S-2419 Ruiz, M. Teresa | Authorizes executive county superintendent of schools to require implementation of shared services arrangements. <i>Jurisdictional issues and concerns.</i> | Senate Education Committee | O |

| S-2557 Smith, Bob Bateman, Christopher | Authorizes municipalities to sell up to three miles of public streets or roads in fee simple or as an easement interest to connect non-contiguous solar electric generation facility sites. | 2 nd Reading in Senate | A |
